Burglary

The first burglary was reported to have taken place at the School of Business on January 4, 2024 between 11:42 p.m. and 12:00 a.m. An unknown male subject is seen on video surveillance taking web cameras from rooms 2200 and 5200 of 4293 Pereira Dr. As seen on the surveillance camera; the suspect is described as male, white, approximately 30 yrs. old, 6'1", medium build, has a brown goatee, wearing a dark hooded sweatshirt, dark pants, and dark tennis shoes.

The second burglary was reported to have taken place at Reines Hall between January 4, 2024 at about 10:00 p.m. and January 5, 2024 at about 9:00 a.m. An unknown subject made entry into two unlocked labs (1st floor and 4th floor) and stole four cell phone chargers, Apple Ear Pods, and two Apple Laptops.
